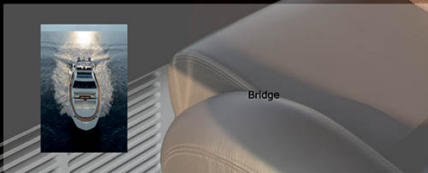

#### Greek Honey & Its Health Benefits

Honey is antibacterial. The bees add an enzyme that makes hydrogen peroxide.

Increase athletic performance. Ancient Olympic athletes would eat honey & dried figs to enhance their performance. This has now been verified with modern studies, showing that it is superior in maintaining glycogen levels & improving recovery time than other sweeteners.

Helps with coughs by reducing cough & throat irritation.

Blood sugar regulation. Even though honey contains simple sugars, it is NOT the same as white sugar or artificial sweeteners. Its exact combination of fructose & glucose actually helps the body regulate blood sugar levels.

Heal wounds & burns. External application of honey has been shown to be as effective as conventional treatment with silver sulfadiazene. It is speculated that the drying effect of the simple sugars & honey's anti-bacterial nature combine to create this effect.

Probiotic. Some varieties of honey possess large amounts of friendly bacteria. This includes up to 6 species of lactobacilli & 4 species of bifidobacteria. This may explain many of the "mysterious therapeutic properties of honey."

Beautiful skin. Its anti-bacterial qualities are particularly useful for the skin & when used with the other ingredients, can also be moisturizing & nourishing!



#### Loukoumades with Greek Honey

Loukoumades are the Greeks' answer to donuts

1kg flour | 1 cup of well boiled rice | 9gr yeast | 20gr baking powder | 250ml orange juice  
250ml sunflower oil | 75ml ouzo | 1 teaspoon salt | orange zest | water | honey | cinnamon

Mix all the ingredient gently while continuously adding warm water until a soft, sticky dough is formed. Cover dough with clean, damp dishtowel. Let dough double in size.

Heat oil in deep fryer. Use a tablespoon to drop batter into hot oil. When batter floats & is golden & puffy, remove to drain on paper towel.
